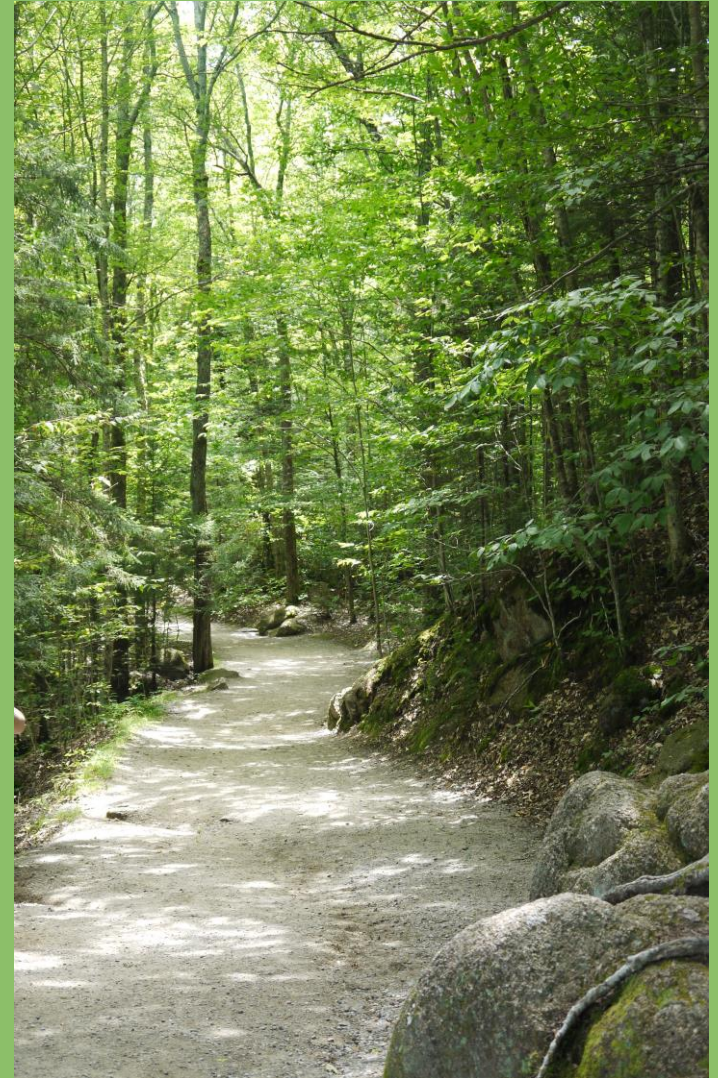

Why do you need a passport?

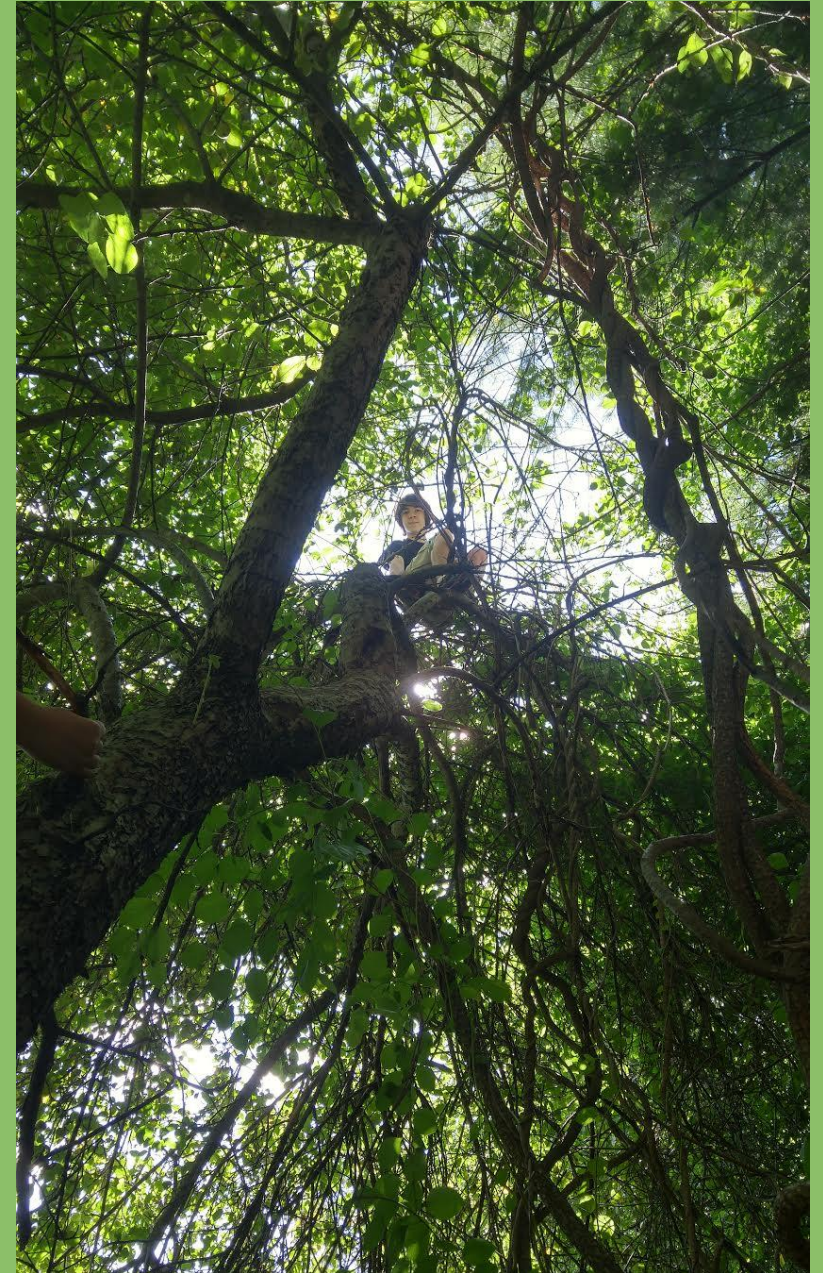
Because passports give you

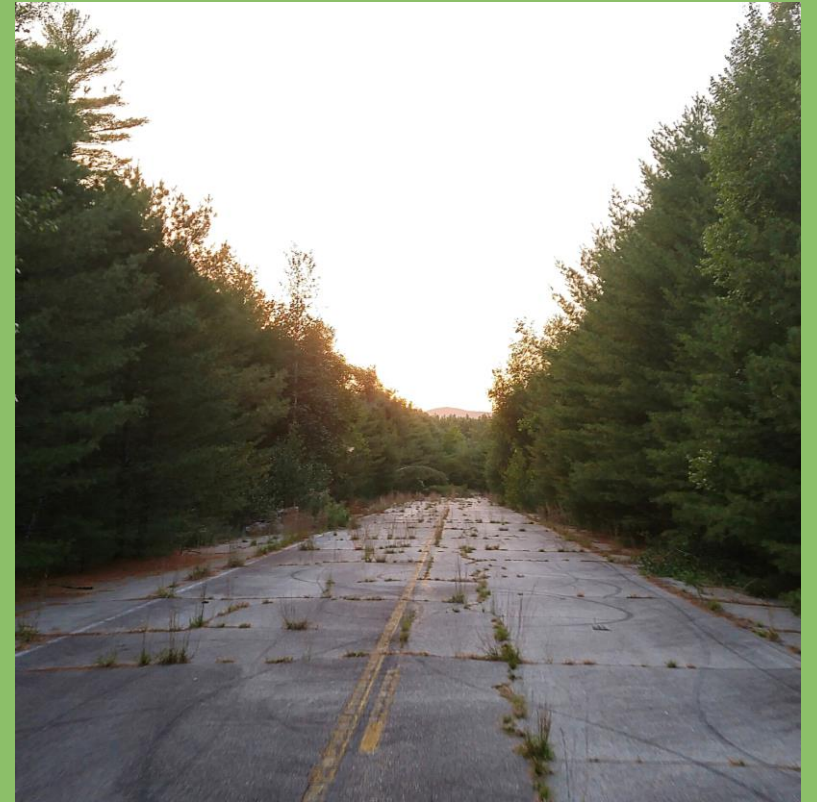
It's time to take the first

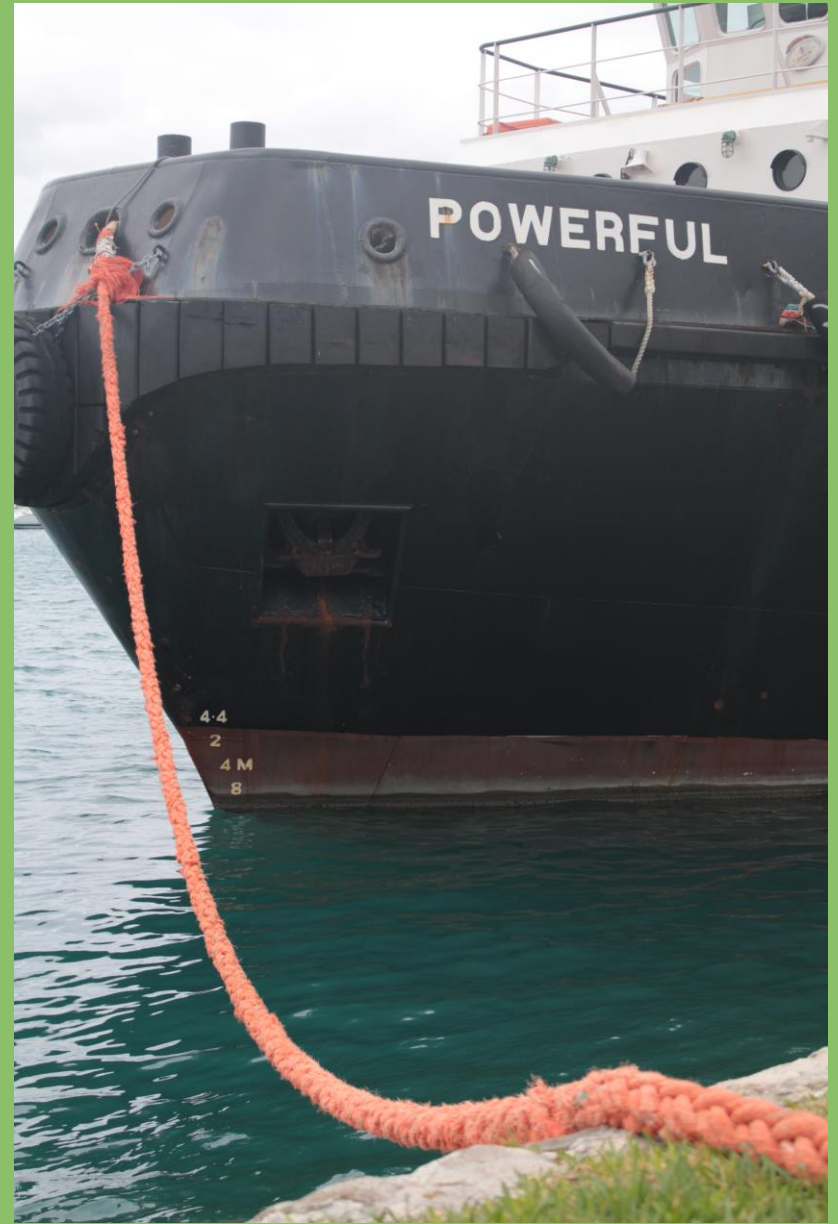

# Get to work this very day. I can help you with a couple first steps

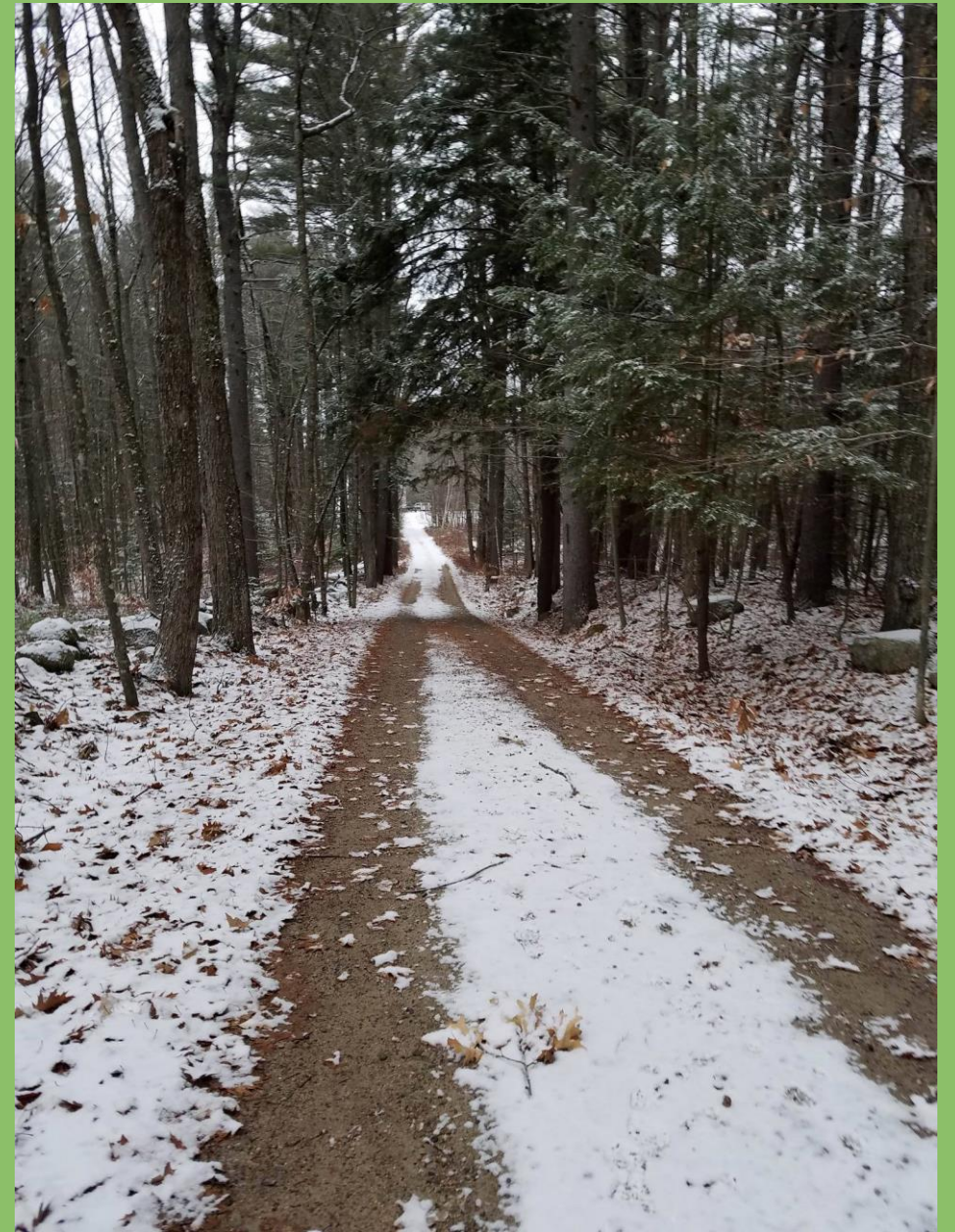
1. Prayer, spend time praying over God's plan for your life. Ask Him to help you overcome things that are holding you stuck.

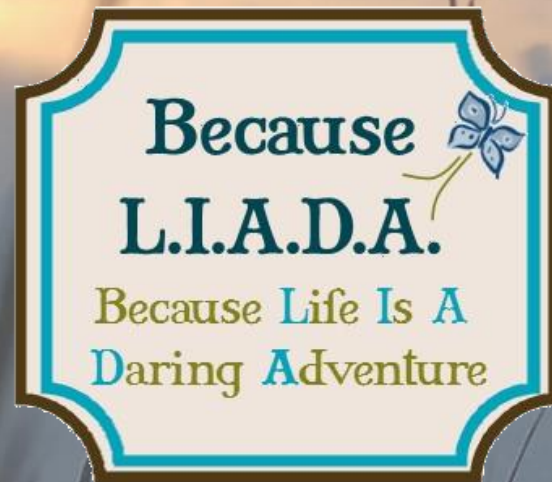
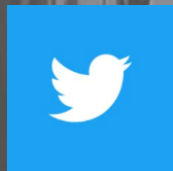
